Study Questions:

1. What is the good news or gospel (see 1 Corinthians 15:1-4)? Why is it so important?
2. How does the truth, "Christ died for our sins," impact you?
3. How does the gospel affect your life on a daily basis?
4. Do you struggle to share the gospel? Why or why not?
5. What does it mean to "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (see Philippians 2:12-13)? What is your part? What is God's part? Why is this God's design for your life?
6. What is the relationship between God's grace and our good works in God's design (see Ephesians 2:8-10)?
7. Does God want everyone to be saved? If so, why are some not saved but condemned (see John 3:16-18)?
