**Study Questions:**

1. If you were in charge of the world's clock, would you slow it down or speed it up? Why?
2. Why do you think the scoffers were questioning the coming of Jesus? What was their argument?
3. How does Peter respond to the scoffers? How does the flood in Noah's day provide insight into what is going to happen in the future?
4. What do vv. 8-9 teach us about God?
5. In light of 2:9 and 2:15, what do you think we should be doing as followers of Jesus? Do you have a desire to see people repent and believe in Jesus? What are you doing to share the Gospel?
6. As we wait for future judgment and the return of Jesus, how should we be living (v. 11)? What does it look like to live a holy and godly life? Be specific.
