3. Do you think our society has changed for the better or worse since God created the world? Why?
4. How aware of you of the created world in your everyday life?
5. What aspect of the created world is most inspiring to you? Why? How does it affect your understanding of God and what he requires of you?
6. What does it mean to be created in God's image? How does knowing this affect how you feel about yourself? About your body? How should this affect your relationship with God? With other people?
7. How does this passage equip you to evaluate the popular beliefs of our culture?
