3. Why is false teaching so dangerous? What are some potential consequences of false teaching?
4. What examples of judgment are given in vv. 4-7? What examples of rescue are given?
5. Are you encouraged by v. 9? How so?
6. How does the promise of future judgment and future rescue impact your daily life?
7. What do verses 20-22 imply about a person's salvation? Can one lose it? Or were these people never converted? Why do you think so?
