4. Conversely, what does the life of someone described in verse 25 look like?
5. In what area of your life could you do a better job at applying God’s Word rather than merely listening to it?
6. How can we help each other to be “doers of the word”?
7. When is anger a sin and when is it not (Ephesians 4:22)? Why? How do you usually deal with anger in your life and behavior?
