Study Questions:

2. What kind of growth do you think should be our main focus: biological growth, transfer growth, prodigal growth, or conversion growth? In your church experience, which of these has been the main source of growth? Why?
3. How can you personally engage in reaching the lost and churchless with the gospel of Jesus?
4. When was the last time you seized an opportunity to witness for Jesus with a churchless person? What happened? How were you able to do that?
5. What holds you back from spreading the word about Jesus? Why?
6. How would you explain the effects of the Resurrection to your non-believing friends?
7. Who are the disciples in your life who encourage your service to Christ? How do they do that?
