Sermon Title: The Advance of the Gospel

Sermon Text: Philippians 1:12-18

Other Relevant Scriptures: Acts 28:30; Luke 21:12-15; 1 Corinthians 9:16-23; Philippians 1:27; Genesis 50:20.

Study Questions:

1. Did anything stand out to you in Sunday's sermon? In what ways were you challenged or encouraged?
2. What are Paul's circumstances as he writes to the Philippians? What is his attitude about his situation?
3. How has Paul's situation helped to advance the gospel?
4. Do you ever feel like your circumstances are not ideal for sharing Jesus with others? Did Paul's circumstances hinder him from proclaiming the gospel? What lesson can we learn from this?
5. In what way are you seeking to advance the gospel? Consider Paul's example in 1 Corinthians 9:19-23.
6. How can God use us to advance the gospel in difficult circumstances?
7. How can we encourage each other in our group to advance the gospel? Consider Paul's hope in Philippians 1:27.
