Study Questions:

1. On a scale of 1 (out of obligation) and 10 (out of joy) how would you rate your usual attitude towards giving money to our church?
2. What have you reaped by being generous to the church (2 Corinthians 9:6)? How can God's promise enable you to be more generous (2 Corinthians 9:8)?
3. How does God value what we give to him materially? By the amount we give (Luke 21:1-4)? How we go about doing it? Why?
4. How do generosity and financial planning and responsibility fit together?
5. How does Jesus want us to approach giving (Matthew 6:1-4)? Do you think giving to support the mission of the church is an expression of seeking first God's kingdom and his righteousness (Matthew 6:25-34)? Explain.
6. Considering this past month, is your "bank" in heaven or on earth (Matthew 6:19-24)? What do you need to do to change accounts?
7. What do the following Scriptures teach us about how we handle material and financial resources: Luke 12:13-21; Luke 12:33-34; 1 Timothy 6:17-19?
