Study Questions:

1. How would you describe the daily life of a disciple of Jesus? What disciplines, speech and behavior should characterize their lives each day?
2. How do we deny ourselves and take up our crosses daily? (v. 23)
3. Are you ever tempted to be ashamed of Jesus and his words? (v. 26)
4. Would you say you are trying to save your life or have you lost it for the sake of Jesus? Explain. (v. 24)
5. How can we live for Jesus every day?
6. God speaks to us through his Word—the Bible. How much have you been hearing from God lately?
7. We speak to God when we pray. What have your prayers to God consisted of this past week? What have you been saying to God?
8. We speak to others about God. Who have you shared Jesus with this past week?

Are you struggling in your obedience to God?

Have you shared Jesus with anyone this past week?

Have you invited anyone to worship or small group?
