2. What is the "grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ"? How can you set your hope on that grace today (1 Peter 1:13)?
3. God is holy. We are to be holy. How can you seek to "be holy in all your conduct"? What does holy conduct consist of?
4. How has being redeemed "with the precious blood of Christ" from the "futile ways inherited from your forefathers" changed your family dynamics (1 Peter 1:18-19)?
5. What does it mean to be ransomed? How did Jesus ransom us (John 1:29; Matthew 20:28; Mark 10:45)?
6. When has the Lord's Supper been particularly meaningful to you? Why?
7. Why is it important for Christians to observe the Lord's Supper?
