### **Study Questions:**

1. What did it mean for Simon Peter, Andrew, James and John to follow Jesus? What does it look like in your daily life to follow Jesus?
2. If someone asked you, “What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus?”, how would you respond to them?
3. Why do you think Jesus told Simon Peter and Andrew that he would make them fishers of men?
4. Who are we supposed to “fish” for in our community? Considering your life-stage and circumstances, what can you do to “fish” for people? What can your small group do together to “fish” for people?
5. In what way does the FirstNSB family and your small group encourage you and challenge you as you seek to live your life as a follower of Jesus?
6. Share the name of someone you can “fish” for in 2018. Will our group commit to praying for these people and encouraging each other as we seek to live as fishers of men?
