Sermon Text: Colossians 3:12-17

Other Relevant Scriptures: Acts 2:46; John 13:34-35; Romans 12:10; 15:7, 14; Galatians 5:13; 6:2; Ephesians 4:2, 32; 5:19; 21; James 5:16.

Study Questions:

1. Considering what Paul mentions in Colossians 3:12-14, what do you find most difficult to “put on.” How can we seek to “put on” these virtues?
2. Why is it so important to “put on love” (v. 14)? Considering this verse as well as John 13:34-35, how should we be loving one another? What does it look like?
3. How do we teach and admonish one another (v. 16)?
4. How does participating in this small group help you obey the “one another” commands in the New Testament?
5. Why do you need regular, consistent participation in a small group to help you grow in Christ?
6. What benefits have you experienced as a result of your participation in this small group?
7. Select one of the “one another” commands and share how your group can practice this command with each other and in our church.
8. How do you develop and deepen relationships with your small group members outside of small group meetings?
9. How does being part of this small group help you to reach out to churchless friends and neighbors?
