Study Questions:

1. What kind of parenting style did you grow up with? Authoritarian? Permissive? Authoritative?
2. Why should children be taught to obey their parents (vv. 1-3)?
3. Has establishing rules worked in your house? If so, how? If not, why not? Give an example of a recent situation?
4. How can parents and particularly fathers bring up their children “in the discipline and instruction of the Lord” (v. 4)? Give some specific actions parents can practice.
5. Who is primarily responsible for the discipleship of children? What role does the church play in the discipleship of children?
6. How can you encourage and reinforce God’s truth to your children in a natural, positive way (Deuteronomy 6:7)?
7. Think about the challenges you face with your kids? Which ones are mountains and which ones are molehills?
