**Ice Breaker Question:** What was your first paying job you had?

**Relate Group Value: Confidentiality** – keeping the group safe by promising that whatever is shared within the group will not be repeated elsewhere, except for leaders' accountability to church supervision or threat of harm to self or others

**Sermon Title: To Follow is to Fish**

Sermon Text: Luke 5:1-11

Other Relevant Scriptures: John 1:35-42; Mark 1:16-20; Matthew 4:18-22; 9:36-38; 28:18-20

1. What do you find most remarkable about this story?
2. Why do you think the crowd was so eager to hear the word of God (v. 1)? What had they heard about Jesus? What did they see Jesus do?
3. What previous experience did Peter have with Jesus (John 1:35-42)?
4. Why do you think Peter responded in the manner described in v. 8? Was he feeling unworthy?
5. Jesus tells Peter, "from now on you will be catching men." (v. 10; also Matthew 4:19 and Mark 1:17). What does this mean? How do we see Peter and other disciples catching men in the Book of Acts?
6. Is catching people the same as making disciples (Matthew 28:19)?
7. How do we go about catching people in our community? What can we do as a church? What can you do as an individual follower of Jesus to catch people?
8. Who's your one? What are you doing to try to "catch" this person for Jesus?

**Weekly Check-up:**

Who's your one? Are you praying for this person regularly? Are you seeking to have a gospel conversation with them?

How is your daily Bible reading going?

How has your prayer life been this past week?

Are you struggling in your obedience to God?

In what ways are you serving in our church?

Are you consistently giving to support the mission of our church?

Have you shared Jesus with anyone this past week?

Have you invited anyone to worship or small group?

What do you need prayer and encouragement for today?
