1. What promises are given to Joshua (vv. 3-5,9)?
2. Which ones ask Joshua to look back and remember what God has done in the past? Which ones ask him to look ahead and believe God for future blessing?
3. Are these promises relevant to your life today? If so, which of God's promises in this passage would be most helpful to you? Why?
4. Which commands accompany the promises? Which would seem most terrifying to one who had to fill Moses' shoes?
5. What is necessary for success and prosperity (v. 8)? What do you think God means here by "success"? Why?
6. Which command given to Joshua (verses 5-8) would be the toughest for you to obey?
7. What challenge lies before you now? How will you succeed at it? What do you fear will hinder you? Who can you rally to help you?
